1) All-stars will not attend the TGCA honor awards luncheon. The Athlete-of-the-Year will be honored at the all-star game of that sport in that division following the M.T. Rice MVP Award presentation.
2) The recognition of the coaches' career victory plaques will be moved from the General Session to the Honor Awards Luncheon.
3) All-star workouts will be reduced by one practice, and all-stars will be brought in for one instead of two nights lodging in each sport.
4) Two softball lectures will be added for softball on Wednesday morning at the convention center to replace the softball demonstration that will be moved to Tuesday morning.
