I started my Coaching Career at **Era ISD**. I was an Assistant Football, Assistant Boys Basketball and Head Boys Track Coach. (Regional qualifiers 1 Boy / 5 events.) Taught HS Math / Elem PE. (1988-89)

In my second year of coaching I took over an **Alvord Girls Athletic Program** that was struggling. No Cross Country Team, a Basketball Program that had not been to the playoffs in 18 years and only a few girls running track. Over the next 19 years I took the XC Program to 15 District Titles, 7 Regional Titles and 2 State Titles, 4 State Runner Up and 3 Bronze Medal teams. 9 times in a 10 year span my teams finished in the top 3 at the state meet and 14 top 5 finishes overall. Individual runners I have coached: 1 State Champion, 2 State Runner-ups and 15 Top 10 runners. In Basketball I led the team to 7 District Titles, 11 Playoff appearances, 4 Regional appearances and a State Finalist team in 1995. I was a 10 time District Titles and 3 Regional Titles. Individuals I coached: 2 State Champions, 10 State Meet Runner-ups and 1 Bronze Medalist runner. In 1995 I helped add Softball as a sport at Alvord HS and coached it until they made the playoffs in 2001. I became the AD and led the '98 Football team to a 11-2 Regional Quarterfinalist season. Taught JH/HS Math. (1989-2008)

I went to **Mansfield HS** as the Head Girls Track coach and took over a 25 member team and quickly grew it to 85 members (D. Weims request). I qualified a relay and 8 runners to Regionals. (Swine Flu year) I also assisted the XC teams to a District Title for the girls and a Regional qualifying boys team. Taught HS Math / HS PE. (2008-09)

I went to **Saint Jo** ISD to run a Girls Program again as the Head XC, Basketball and Track teams. I led the XC team to a District Title and 2 Regional Appearances and 2 State Qualifiers. In Basketball I led them to 2 playoffs appearances, one to the Area round and one to the Regional Quarterfinals. In Track they won a District Title, 8 Area Meet qualifiers and 2 relays and had 5 individuals and 2 relays qualify for Regionals. Taught JH/HS Math. (2009-2011)

I returned to **Alvord** as the **Athletic Director** and quickly won another Girls XC District Title, Regional Title and a fourth place State Meet finish. I brought back Volleyball as a sport in 2013 (dropped in 1986 for lack of participation). Taught 6th PE (2011-2014)

I finished up my career in **Burleson** as the Head Girls Basketball Coach and led them to a District Championship in '14-'15, (last was 1998) and an Area Playoff run in my first year. I

also took over the Boys and Girls XC Programs in year 3 at Burleson and led both teams to 3 straight Regional appearances and 1 State Qualifier (boy). Taught HS Math. (2014 - 2019)

My **Parents** (both retired teachers/admin) run the Family Farm in Decatur and they were both having health problems and I felt I needed to **retire** and help them keep the farm running.

I was a multi-sport athlete (football, basketball, track and tennis) at **Decatur HS** and inducted into the **Wall of Fame in 2017** (Inaugural Class). I was a multi-sport Head Coach for 27 of my 31 years. I wanted my players to have the opportunity to be multi-sport athletes as well. I believed that the Program came first, athletes staying in a competitive atmosphere and Coaches sharing athletes was essential to a program's success. I really enjoyed the process that went into coaching. I spent most of my free time trying to create the perfect practice plan for each sport I coached, troubleshooting for what might go wrong and trying to master the art of motivating athletes. I believe that if you are going to make decisions that will change people's lives then you should really get to know the peoples lives you are going to change. It is also crucial to surround yourself with as many like minded people/coaches as possible to increase your success opportunities. One of my main goals each year was to **UNIFY** the Community, Faculty, Coaches, and Athletes.

Wife **Rhonda (32 years)**, a retired Teacher/Coach (34 years) we coached together for 22 years. She was a recipient of the **TGCA** Assistant Coach of the Year Award (3A and Under)

Daughter **Whitney** played Basketball at Mississippi College in Clinton MS and earned her Degree/Masters from MC and is currently the Head Boys and Girls Cross Country Coach and Assistant Track at Burleson HS.

Son **Logan** has his Degree/Masters from Texas A&M University and coached 3 years at Azle JH and currently is an Assistant Principal at Decatur JH (McCarrol).
