Frequently Asked Questions

You have been selected a TGCA All-Star, now what?

- Fill out the necessary paperwork at the link provided in email to your high school coach
- Submit the google doc with your headshot photo and current year physical attached

Do I have to fill out the form if I am not going to play? Can I just email you?

 No, if you do not intend to play, it is imperative you let me know as soon as possible so I can move up another deserving athlete. Please fill out the decline form.

What does being selected as an All-Star entail?

- Volleyball, Basketball, and Softball
 Attend Orientation. Go to Prep, this time will be used going over the drills the coaches are going to show the member coaches at the Demonstrations. Take team photos and FCA box lunch. The teams and their High School coach will be introduced before the game. Play the game. Dismissed after the MVP announcement.
- Cross Country/Track
 Attend Orientation. Go to Prep, this time will be used going over the drills the coaches are going to show the member coaches at the Demonstrations. Take team photos and FCA box lunch. The teams and their High School coaches will be introduced at half-time of the basketball game. The all-star will be dismissed after half-time.
- Cheer

Attend Orientation. Go to Prep, this time is used to learn cheers and the dance to be used during the basketball games at halftime. Take team photos and FCA box lunch. Cheer will be introduced at the beginning of the basketball game and perform at halftime. Dismissed at the end of the game.

What is the Schedule?

- Arrive by 2pm on the date of your orientation
 - The typical sports schedule will be:

2:00pm Orientation- You will receive your equipment at that time

2:30pm Game prep

4:30pm Box lunch, FCA Devotional (optional), Team Picture

6:00pm Demonstration - this is for the coaches in attendance. During demo, each player will announce to the audience their name, high school, & high school coach. Cheer does not do a demonstration but will perform at halftime of the basketball game.

7:00pm Game Introductions - you will be escorted by your high school coach.

■ 7:30pm Game

■ 8:00pm Halftime of Basketball game, Intro of CC/Track All-Stars, Cheer Performance.

10:00pm Dismissal - after the game

What do All-Stars need to bring?

Volleyball, Basketball, Softball CC/Track and Cheer athletes need to bring

Shoes/socks for workout and game

Workout clothes

Softball Players need to bring:

Catchers -- Catchers need to bring their own equipment. Please get with your school and arrange.

Gloves, Bats -- Players will need to bring their own gloves. Bats will not be supplied, please bring your own.

Helmets – Each player must bring their own batting helmet.

Will Trainers be available to the All-Stars?

The TGCA provides All-Star trainers from all over Texas. They will be at workouts and the games to assist the athletes if needed.

Do we get any All-Star swag?

We are at the mercy of our corporate sponsors, but we try to get the all-stars items for them to keep. In the past, the all-stars have received an assortment of items from our corporate sponsors.

Do we need to bring food?

The TGCA in cooperation with the FCA, will provide each all-star with a box lunch during the time between workouts and demonstration. Also, during this time the FCA will hold an optional devotional.

Can parents take pictures and video?

Yes, we encourage the parents to document this event any way they can.

What is the Admission to the all-star games?

Does the TGCA provide All-Stars with a hotel room?

The legacy team does **NOT** play an all-star game. They just receive a certificate.
