What kind of info will I be receiving prior to the All-Star games?

- When the teams are finalized, check the It will include:

What is the Schedule?

- Arrive by 2pm on the date of your orientation
 - The typical sports schedule will be:
 - **2:00pm** **Orientation-** You will receive your equipment at that time
 - **2:30pm** **Game prep**
 - **4:30pm** **Box lunch, FCA Devotional (optional), Team Picture**
 - **6:00pm** **Demonstration** - this is for the coaches in attendance. During demo, each player will announce to the audience their name, high school, & high school coach. Cheer does not do a demonstration but will perform at halftime of the basketball game.
 - **7:00pm** **Game Introductions** - you will be escorted by your high school coach.
 - **7:30pm** **Game**
 - **10:00pm** **Dismissal** - after the game and uniforms are taken up, you will be dismissed

What do All-Stars need to bring?

Volleyball, Basketball, Softball CC/Track and Cheer athletes need to bring

Workout shoes/socks
Workout clothes

Softball Players need to bring:

Catchers -- Catchers need to bring their own equipment. Please get with your school and arrange.

Gloves, Bats -- Players will need to bring their own gloves. Bats will not be supplied, please bring your own

Helmets – Each player must bring their own batting helmet.

Will Trainers be available to the All-Stars?

The TGCA provides All-Star trainers from all over Texas. They will be at workouts and the games to assist the athletes if needed.

Do we get any All-Star swag?

We are at the mercy of our corporate sponsors, but we try to get the all-stars items for them to keep. In the past, the all-stars have received shoes in all sports, a TGCA long sleeve t-shirt, an All-Star shirt provided by Gandy Ink and other things, depending our corporate sponsors.

Do we need to bring food?

The TGCA in cooperation with the FCA, will provide each all-star with a box lunch during the time between workouts and demonstration. Also, during this time the FCA will hold an optional devotional.
