

Billy Joe and Betty Oliver served as Supervisors of Business Exhibits at summer TGCA clinics for twenty years, from 1982 through 2001. Billy Joe served as Junior or Senior Director of TGCA for four years during the 1960s and '70's. He has served on numerous committee including All-Star selection committees. He was selected by TGCA members as Honor Coach in 1986 for his contributions to girls athletics in the state of Texas.

Billy Joe is a 1947 graduate of Troy High School, received a BS degree from Abilene Christian College in 1951, and a Masters Degree from Southwest Texas State in 1957. Betty graduated from Stockdale High School in 1950. She has college credits from Temple College, McLennan Community College, and Abilene Christian College.

Billy Joe taught and coached at Troy ISD from 1951 through 1963. His Junior High teams won four district championships which included three undefeated seasons. His Troy High School teams had a record of 101 wins and 61 losses. He had three district championships and three appearances in regional finals. From 1963 to 1975 he coached the Robinson Junior High teams, winning 240 games losing 32, with four undefeated teams. In the years 1975 through 1978 he coached Robinson High School girls with a record of 76 wins and 27 losses. His teams were regional finalist for three years and state runner-up in Class AA in 1977.

Billy Joe served as elementary principal for Robinson for 25 years, retiring in 1988. Betty retired in 1991 after working for Robinson ISD and Waco ISD for twenty-one years.

The Olivers now reside in Temple, Texas. They have four sons , all graduates of Robinson High School. All have college degrees including Bachelor Degrees, Masters Degrees, and one PHD.
