## ACL Injury Facts

- Female athletes suffer ACL tears at a rate two to six times greater than do male athletes participating in the same sports.
- Seventy percent of ACL tears are non-contact injuries that typically occur as an athlete lands from a jump or steps abruptly to pivot. Studies show that among many risk factors for non-contact ACL tears, neuromuscular control appears to be the primary reason for the different injury rates between sexes.
- Also, video analysis reveals females tend to land differently than do males. Females typically land in a more upright, knock-kneed posture, an at risk position that often leads to the "point of no return" and serious ACL injury.
- In addition to a significant reduction of medical costs, the prevention of ACL tears will eliminate the need for surgical reconstruction, the risk of secondary knee-joint problems, a full season lost from competition, a potential loss of scholarship funding, and the potential deleterious effects on the athlete's performance and psychological health.
- While research is still ongoing, studies show that neuromuscular training programs reduce non-contact ACL injury rates. Most neuromuscular training programs, however, focus only on strength, agility, and jump skill instruction with relatively little emphasis on core stability.
- Core muscle function influences anatomical structures from the low back to the foot, but most prominently the knee. The core thus provides a stable platform for the movement of the lower extremity: legs, hips, and buttocks. For that reason, the knee-joint position at landing is strongly influenced by core function. Athletes with delayed trunk muscle function or hip weakness have increased potential for core instability. If the core is unstable, the knee joint at landing is more likely to be in an "at-risk" position for ACL injury. Core instability may be the primary reason that females tend to land from a jump in the more upright, knock-kneed posture. Proper intervention and core-stability training from a qualified CORE instructor can optimize correct landing position, enhance neuromuscular control, and reduce the risk of ACL tear. The core is the key.

The Texas Girls Coaches Association, under its Coaches Education Program of special lectures at our 2007 TGCA Summer Clinic, will offer the CORE Program on Wednesday, July 11. The CORE Program is a comprehensive regimen designed to strengthen the midsection of the athlete. The program is tailored to decrease and even prevent ACL tears, particularly in the female athlete, while significantly improving athletic performance. This concept was designed and will be taught by Corey Eaton, a Certified/Licensed Athletic Trainer and Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist. He will be assisted by Dr. Scott O. Paschal, M.D., of the Dallas Orthopedic Center, known for his work in sports injuries and the arthroscopic and reconstructive surgery of the knee and shoulder.

"We are so fortunate for the CORE Program to be offered under the Coaches Education Program to our coaches, in all sports, attending our clinic this summer in Austin", according to Sam Tipton, Executive Director of the Texas Girls Coaches Association. "Dr. Bill Farney (III), Dr. Charles Bestthaupt (III), and I were invited by the Dallas Orthopedic Center to witness first-hand the CORE Program designed and being used by Corey Eaton in selected pilot programs in the metroplex area. We were highly impressed with the proven results and the potential the program has in the prevention of ACL injuries. I encourage all our coaches to take advantage of the opportunity to attend one of the two lectures and demonstrations of this revolutionary prevention program for ACL injuries in female athletes."
