JANET RAYFIELD

- ⇒ Six consecutive NCAA College Cup appearances from 2003-08
- ⇒ Has 145 total career wins as a collegiate head coach
- ⇒ Played 18 years of amateur and professional soccer
- ⇒ Coached 11 first team All-Big Ten players and 49 Academic All-Big Ten Honorees.
- ⇒ As a player she led the North Carolina Tar Heels to the first-ever NCAA championship in 1982, first of 18 national titles in the storied history of UNC program.
- ⇒ Finished her playing career at UNC with 93 goals (2nd in school history) and 223 points (3rd in school history).
